R. 5 E. containing 83 1/2 acres of Land more or less.

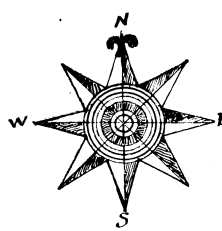

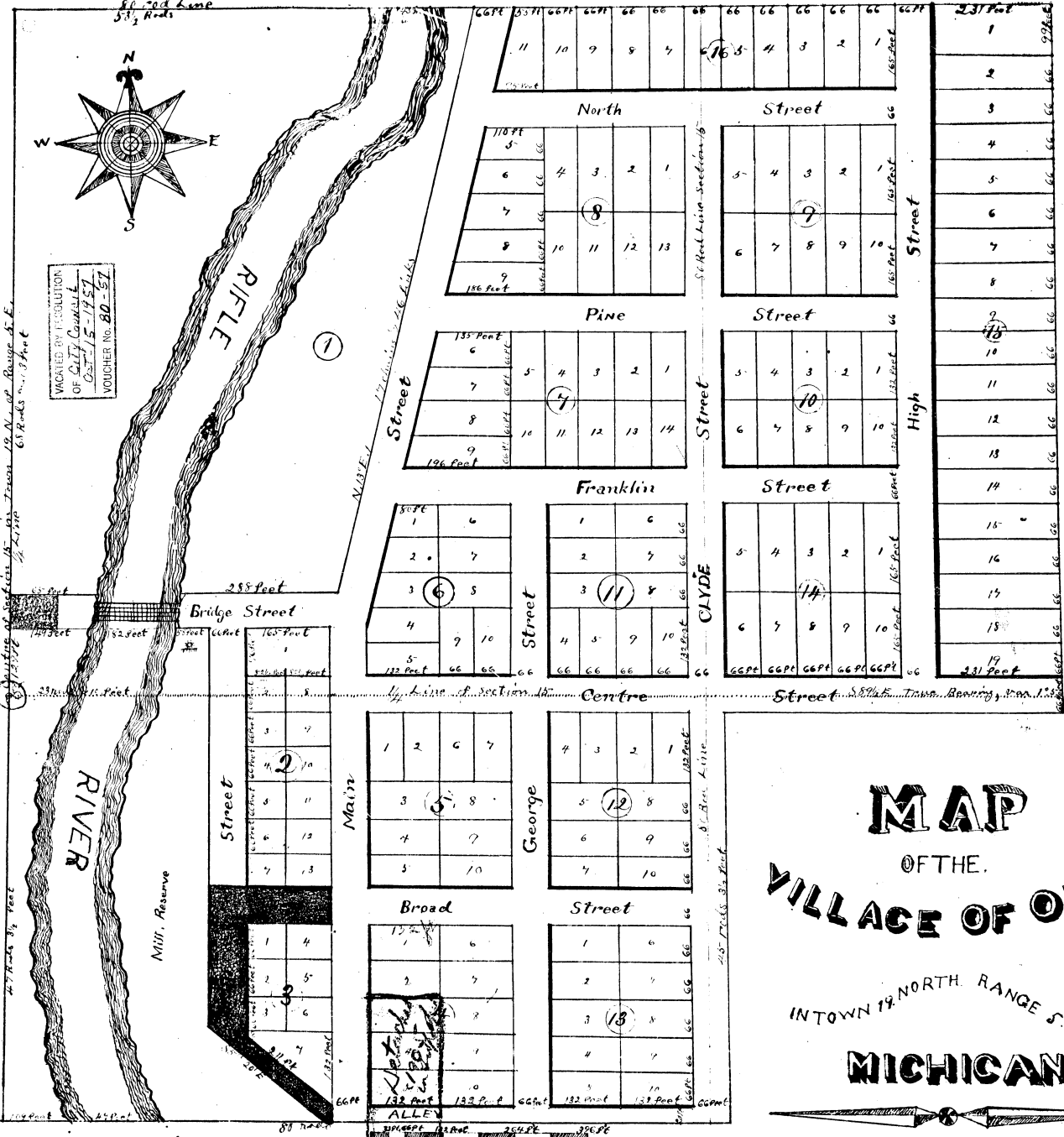
