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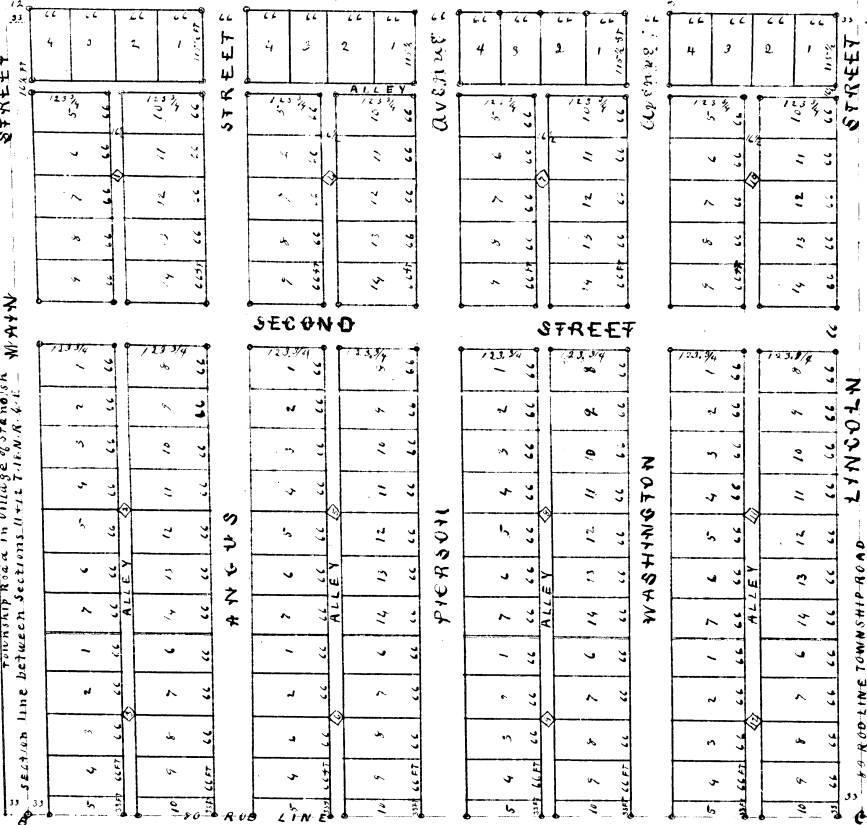

Courses & width of streets & alleys &c.
 All the streets and alleys in this plat run either north and south or east and west as the case may be. The former Parallel with west boundary of Plat, and the latter Parallel with north boundary. The streets are all sixty six feet wide & the alleys are 16 1/2 feet or one rod wide.

Size of Lots
 Lots are generally 66 feet wide & 123 feet long unless otherwise marked on the plat. The northwest tier of lots are 116 feet long. While the south tier of lots in the plat are of the usual length, but are only 55 feet wide.

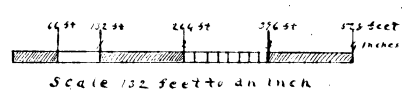

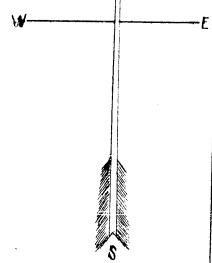
