It is a requirement that any prospective General Contractor bidding attend this meeting. Representatives of the Drainage District and Spicer Group, Inc. will be present to discuss the project. Attendance is required for sealed bids to be accepted. Spicer Group, Inc. will transmit to all prospective bidders of record an Addendum as Spicer Group, Inc. considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be legally effective.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for each Division giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders.
