



ARENAC COUNTY PARKS CAMPGROUND RULES

The following information and rules are intended to provide an enjoyable and safe family camping experience for you and your family and your camping neighbors. Violations of these rules could result in early departure without refund.

Registration: All campers must register at the office prior to setting up camp. No alternating of campsites without prior management approval.

Check In Time: 3pm

Check Out Time: 11am

- **Limit of (8) people per site : (2) tents or (1) RV & (1) tent per site**
- Early check in or late departures must be pre-arranged with management
- All visitors must register at office and leave by 9pm.

Campsite Parking: Registered campers are allowed one (1) vehicle within the boundaries of their campsite.

- Extra space for additional vehicles and boats is available in the visitor's parking lot.

Speed limit is **5 MPH** throughout entire campground, please keep our children safe.

Quiet time is between **10pm-8am** daily. Holiday weekends **11pm-8am**.

- Please be considerate of your neighbors. Radios & TV's should not be heard beyond your campsite.

Camp Fires: All campfires must be contained within the provided fire pits.

- Firewood is for sale at the office. No cutting of tree's or branches on campground property.

Maintenance: All campsites must be kept neat and clean of debris at all times.

Trash: Trash can be disposed of at the dumper or at the edge of campsite when you leave.

Disruptive Behavior: If the police are called by another camper, or by management due to disruptive behavior or vandalism the camper will be immediately required to leave the campground. No refunds to any person in this situation. Please do not put yourself and management in this situation.

No ORV's are allowed in the park.

Discharge of Firearms are **PROHIBITED** in the campground.

NO PETS ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARK OR CAMPGROUND.

Insurance and Theft: We are checking the campground constantly, but we are not responsible in the case of RV or contents there of; nor for any damages caused by natural causes (i.e., tree falling, wind, hail damage). Arenac County Parks and Recreation will not be responsible for injury to guest or of the loss of money or valuables.
