EMS MILLAGE

Shall the County of Arenac renew its levy of .75 mill, plus add an additional .60 mill for a total levy of 1.35 mills (being \$1.35 for every \$1,000.00 of Taxable Value), upon all real and personal property within the County of Arenac, Michigan, under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution for a period of two (2) years; 2023-2024 inclusive, for the purpose of exclusively financing emergency

medical response within the County?

RENEWAL OF E-911 CENTRAL DISPATCH MILLAGE

Shall the County of Arenac renew its tax levy of 1.35 mills (being \$1.35 for every \$1,000.00 of Taxable Value) upon all real and personal taxable property in the County of Arenac, Michigan, under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution, for a period of four (4) years; being 2023 through 2026 inclusive, for the purpose of 911 call answering and dispatch within Arenac County, including facilities, equipment and operations?

**AU GRES SIMS SCHOOL DISTRICT
OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Au Gres-Sims School District, Arenac County, Michigan, be increased by 17.508 mills (\$17.508 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2023 to 2028, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; this is a renewal of millage that expired with the 2022 tax levy?

**STANDISH-STERLING COMMUNITY SCHOOLS
OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 18.95 mills (\$18.95 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Standish-Sterling Community Schools, Arenac, Gladwin and Bay Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 10 years, 2023 to 2032, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2022 tax levy)?

LIBRARY:

IOSCO-ARENAC DISTRICT LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the Iosco-Arenac District Library, Counties of Iosco and Arenac, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy a millage annually in an amount not to exceed .4912 mill (\$.4912 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage that expires in 2023, against all taxable property within the Iosco-Arenac District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2024 to 2033, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law?
