Description of Land Platted
 The land embraced in the annexed Plat of **Glenwood Beach** consists of Lot 3 in Section 14 T19 N. R. 7 E. and is described as follows: Commencing at the N.W. corner of Section 14 running thence east on Section line 39 chains and 96 links to the full quarter part of said section 14, thence south on the North and South quarter line 19 chains and 77 links to the meander line of the government survey of **Saginaw Bay**, thence N77°35'W along meander line 23 chains and 20 links thence N74°04' 50 chains to meander post between sections 14 and 15, thence S88°34'W on section line 7, chains and 21 links to place of beginning containing 52.63 acres.
 The assumed variation of Magnetic meridian is 3°20'W
