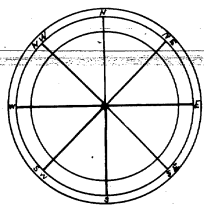


VILLAGE OF WORTH ARENAC COUNTY MICH.



Scale 200 FT = 1 Inch

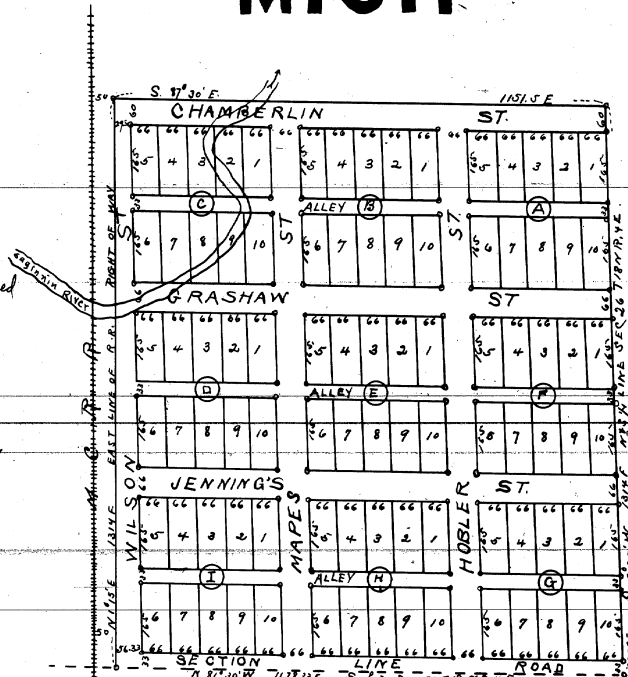
