

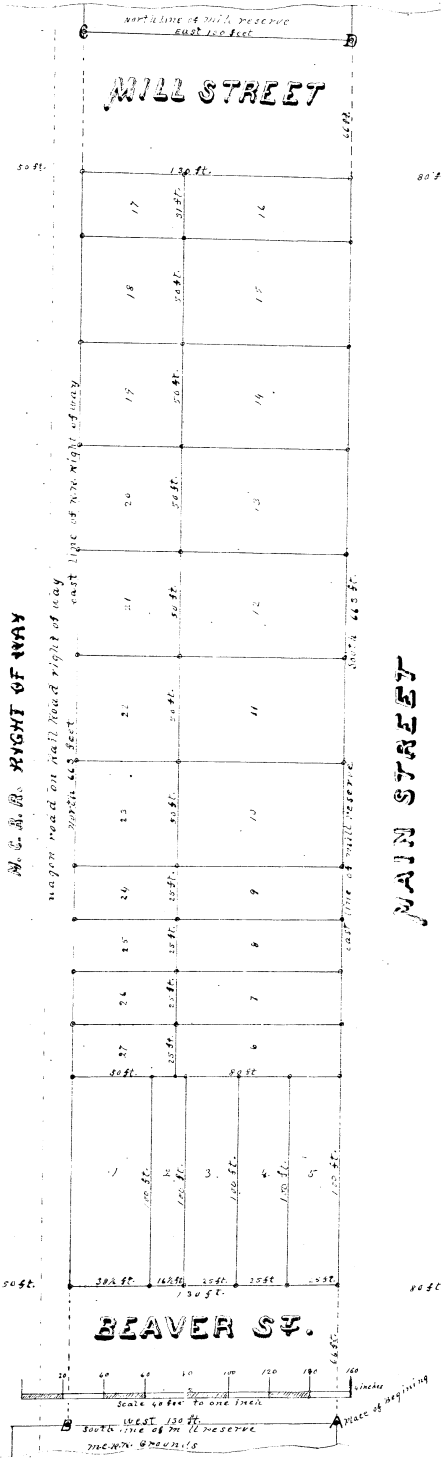

Course and widths of Streets

The streets marked "Mill Street" and "Beaver St." on this plat are a continuation of the same streets marked "Mill Street" and "Beaver St." in the original plat of the village of Standish, and are each 150 feet wide, the former running parallel with the north boundary, and the latter parallel with the south boundary.
