The land here platted to be known as the Squire and Sterling Addition to the Village of Omer, is that portion of the North West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Sec. 15, Town 17 North, Range 5 East, as described as follows, and commencing at a point on the North side of said Sec. 15, N. 75 E., one chain and ninety four links East of a corner of said Section line nine (9) chains South 88° 35' West, (4) four chains and sixty seven links to the center of the highway of the Township of Arenac, in the North East Quarter of said Sec. 15, N. 75 E., one chain and ninety four links East of said highway, and (4) four chains and sixty seven links East of said highway, including 1/2 of said highway (4) acres and 1/8 of an acre.

**COURSES OF STREETS**  
 The street called "Main Street" is an established highway of the Township of Arenac, in the North East Quarter of Sec. 15, Town 17 North, Range 5 East, and is 40 feet wide and bears S 88° 35' W. The street called "Petersen Street" is 24.25 feet wide and bears N 75° E. The street called "Alley" is 10 feet wide and bears S 88° 35' W.

**MONUMENTS, WITNESS MARKS Etc.**

At all the corners in the boundaries of the above plat, witness marks were set consisting of iron stakes one and one-half inches in diameter and two (2) feet long driven firmly into the ground.

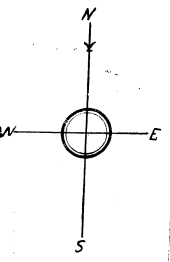
